- 1 1104 S. Wabash (EC)**
Check In & Computer Lab 1
Most of the day's activities take place here; a computer lab that we've reserved for the day is also in this building.
- 2 600 S. Michigan (ACC)**
Student Financial Services, Graduate Office, Records Office
Many of our administrative services are located here and are open Monday through Friday during normal business hours.
- 3 618 S. Michigan (SE)**
Multicultural Affairs & Computer Lab 2
Visit this newly renovated space for Multicultural Affairs and the second computer lab we've reserved for registration.

Book Store & Library
