Please carefully review the following Graduate Program information regarding the **Lya Dym Rosenblum Award** including application and allocation process:

1. The signature on the application form signifies that the graduate program supports the candidate applying for the conference money, the graduate's intention to attend the conference listed on the application form, and the money was applied to the conference listed on the application form.
2. The committee will distribute as many awards in increments of \$500 or less depending on the conference fees, and the number of applications received by the due date. The total sum of money distributed for the fall and spring semesters is \$3000.
3. Students applying for the Rosenblum award who are presenting at the conferences will be given priority.
4. **The application due date for the 2007-2008 Rosenblum award will be February 1, 2008.**
5. Beginning in the 2008-2009 school year, the Rosenblum applications will be due on the first Friday of the fall and spring semesters.
6. The Lya Dym Rosenblum committee will evaluate the process after the first series of awards have been distributed in 2008 and report back to the GPC with updates and suggestions for the future allocations of the funds.
