2. 15-20 Images – We recommend work from one or two sustained projects. A portfolio that demonstrates an ambitious commitment to exploring one subject or idea is an important plus.
  - Please submit a consistent set of (matted or unmatted) prints. No slides or digital submissions will be accepted.
3. A statement describing your work and (optional) a short statement about why you are seeking this/these scholarship(s).

Only one set of work is required, regardless of how many scholarships are being pursued. Please label all submitted materials and the container with your name. Include your contact information: phone and email.
