**CRITERIA FOR WCRX PRODUCTION PRACTICUM 41-3400**

WCRX Production Practicum is intended for the advanced student and requires a minimum of ten hours per week. Using advanced production studio facilities, students write, voice, and technically produce station promos, public service announcements, and other projects for airing on WCRX.

You will be responsible for conceiving, writing and editing promos, Public Service Announcements, station imaging as well as other projects. You must attend a weekly practicum meeting according to the semester's schedule. You must display a professional and mature attitude, properly follow the rules and regulations of WCRX and treat this opportunity as you would at an internship or job in a major market city.

**The following is required PRIOR to applying for a specialty position.**

You must submit a SAMPLE 2 minute air check of the format you would like to do. This is due 2 weeks before you are allowed to register for practicum.

You must submit a sample weekly play list documenting all the songs you will play during your specialty show.

Students must have completed and passed the following courses to be considered:

41-2407 Radio Production II: Intermediate

It is recommended that you have completed the following courses prior to your practicum experience:

Radio Broadcasting II (may be taken concurrently)

Writing for Radio

Voice and Articulation

Theatre of the Mind

**YOU MUST BE APPROVED BY THE WCRX DIRECTOR PRIOR TO REGISTERING FOR THE WCRX PRACTICUM. All WCRX positions are for 2 credit hours. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for all student positions on WCRX.**
