THE BOB ENRIETTO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM was established through the generosity of Bob Enrietto's sister, Jean Kralka, in honor of Bob's commitment and dedication to Columbia College Chicago's Semester in L.A. program, where Bob served as Director for 7 years. The Semester in L.A. is an intensive program that provides qualified full-time Columbia students the opportunity to experience the daily operations of the entertainment industry through its presence on a working Hollywood studio lot in Los Angeles, California. The Bob Enrietto Scholarship is awarded to one (1) student each semester to help defray the additional living expenses associated with the Semester in L.A. program. The scholarship award is \$1,500.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be considered for the Bob Enrietto Scholarship, students must:

- Be accepted to the Semester in L.A. program and enroll full-time.
- Have earned a cumulative g.p.a. of 3.0 or better at Columbia College Chicago.
- Have completed 80 credit hours by the end of the Spring semester (at least 24 of which must have been completed at Columbia College Chicago).

HOW TO APPLY

To be considered for the Bob Enrietto Scholarship, please submit the following materials by March 15, 2009 for the Summer 2009 semester, April 15, 2009 for the Fall 2009 semester or November 15, 2009 for the Spring 2010 semester:

- A completed Bob Enrietto Scholarship application;
- An unofficial copy of your Columbia College Chicago transcript (Unofficial copies can be obtained through OASIS at <http://oasis.colum.edu>);
- One letter of recommendation from the Chairperson or Associate Chairperson in your major department;
- One letter of recommendation from a faculty member in your major department who can comment on your accomplishments, talents or abilities in that major;
- Original essay that explains why you have chosen to attend the Semester in L.A. and where you plan to be in five years. Essay must be typed and double-spaced, with your name and Oasis ID number clearly marked on each page in the upper right hand corner. Essay must be no shorter than 500 words and no longer than 1,000 words. Attach your essay to the Bob Enrietto Scholarship Application.
- Brief description of your most significant creative work completed at Columbia College Chicago.

Note: Scholarship applications, accompanying essays and letters of recommendation become the property of Columbia College Chicago and are not returned to students, nor are they available to students for photocopying or perusal.

SCHOLARSHIP TERMS

- The maximum award is \$1,500 to help defray the additional costs associated with the Semester in L.A. program;
- Students may receive the award only during the semester in which they live in L.A. as part of the Semester in L.A. program;
- Students who elect not to attend the semester in L.A. program will forfeit the scholarship and will need to reapply if they decide to attend in another semester.
- Students must be enrolled full-time in the Semester in L.A. program and must adhere to the policies and procedures that are unique to the program.
- The rules governing other sources of financial aid (federal, state, institutional and other grants, gifts or loans) will apply.
- Columbia College Chicago reserves the right to withhold the award in any year in which, at its sole discretion, suitable candidates cannot be found among applicants.

Robert F. Enrietto, Jr., was a production manager, assistant director, producer and, in recent years, administrator of Columbia College Chicago's "Semester in L.A." program. A Chicago native and 1967 graduate of Columbia, Enrietto had movie credits that included "Harold and Maude", "Tora! Tora! Tora!", "Phantom of the Paradise", and "The Outside Man", among others. His TV credits include "In the Heat of the Night," "Remington Steele," "Behind Enemy Lines," "Something About Amelia," "Little House On the Prairie" and "Hawaii Five-O," among many others.

His most cherished accomplishment was the creation of Columbia College Chicago's "Semester in L.A." program, which he created together with fellow instructor Don Smith. Believing that the college should have a presence in Hollywood, Bob helped develop a program of classes based at CBS Studio Center in Studio City, California, which today includes screenwriting, adaptation, entertainment marketing, producing, comedy writing for television, costume design, development, directing, music composition for the screen, and music producing.
