## Photo doc day

During Portfolio Boot Camp eligible students will have the opportunity to have their work or themselves photographed. A professionally made photograph makes a noticeable difference when you're trying to highlight your art, your designs or yourself. Boot Camp Week will feature a Photo Doc/Headshot Day that will allow you to receive photography assistance for your portfolio samples.

You can request photography assistance for:

- Fine Art, Fashion, Interior Architecture and Product Design samples
- Headshots or promotional photography of yourself (this service is open to performers, musicians and writers)

Students must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Students participating in the Photo Documentation service may bring up to 10 samples to be photographed, all of which must be able to fit through a standard-sized door.
- All photography must be relevant to your portfolio.
- All materials (including yourself) should be prepared to be photographed prior to the day of the photo shoot. Students are responsible for any framing, make-up or styling of the objects / persons to be photographed.
- Image printing and reproduction is the student's responsibility. The Portfolio Center will provide a list of printing resources.
