

Committee Descriptions

All communications between the committee and administrative offices must be approved by the Executive Board of Student Government.

Student Affairs Committee- addresses issues related to student life at Columbia and works with the Student Affairs office at the college, as well as with other existing organizations on campus to achieve common goals.

Student Academic Affairs Committee- addresses issues related to academics at Columbia and utilizes academic resources on campus and correlating administration to achieve objectives.

Student Campus Environment Committee- addresses issues concerning campus facilities.

Graduate Student Affairs Committee- addresses issues regarding graduate student concerns.

Student Financial Affairs Committee- Chaired by the VP of Finance, the committee shall review fund requests and address college-related financial concerns for students.

Public Relations Committee- Chaired by the VP of Communications, the committee shall work to create and maintain brand awareness for the SGA throughout the Columbia community.

VIP- It's main purpose is to recruit new students into the SGA.

Elections and Rules Committee- addresses all issues related to holding free and fair elections for positions within the SGA. Usually convenes in the Spring semester.
