Communications	Communications
Total of three courses (9 sem. hrs.) Two course (6 sem. hrs.) sequence in writing; English Composition I and II. One course (3 sem. hrs.) in oral communications.	ENG 101 & 102. SPH 101.
Mathematics	Mathematics
One course (3 sem. hrs.) in college level mathematics or higher.	MTH 101 or Higher.
Computer Applications	Computer Applications
One course (3 sem. hrs.) in Computer Applications.	CIS 110
Science	Sciences
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) of science, either physical or life science; one course must have a laboratory component.	Any College Level, ATY or BIO or CHM or GLY or PHY or SCI or ZOL or GEO 115.
History	History
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) of history.	Any College Level, HIS or INS 131,133,135 & 139.
Humanities	Humanities
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) with one course in the comparative study of the arts and the other selected from approved humanities courses.	Any College Level, HUM or ART 115,151,152,153, or INS 204 or MUS 103,105,106,107.
Literature	Literature
One course (3 sem. hrs.) in literature.	Any College Level, LIT.
Social Science	Social Science
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) in social science with courses selected from two different disciplines.	Any College Level, ATR or BEC or POS or PSY or SOC or GEO 116 or INS 100 & 107.
General Education Electives	General Education Electives
One course (3 sem. hrs.) selected from science, history, humanities, literature, mathematics, social science.	May be completed by taking additional courses from the above beyond the required number of semester hours.
Senior Seminar	
One course (3 sem. hrs.) in ethics, to be taken at Columbia as a capstone general education experience.	
Total 16 courses (48 sem. hrs.)
