<b>Science</b>	<b>Sciences</b>

<b>Literature</b>	<b>Literature</b>
One course (3 sem. hrs.) in literature.	ENGL 2613,2623,1713,1853,2533
<b>Social Science</b>	<b>Social Science</b>
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) in social science with courses selected from two different disciplines.	ANTH 1713, 1743; ECON 1553,1563; GEOG 1513; PLSC 1513,1523; PSYC 1813,2553,2773; SOCY 2513,2523,2553
<b>General Education Electives</b>	<b>General Education Electives</b>
One course (3 sem. hrs.) selected from science, history, humanities, literature, mathematics, social science.	May be completed by taking additional courses from the above, beyond the required number of courses.

One course (3 sem. hrs.) in ethics, to be taken at Columbia as a capstone general education experience.
