One course (3 sem. hrs.) in college level mathematics or higher.	Math 118 or higher
<b>Computer Applications</b>	<b>Computer Applications</b>
One course (3 sem. hrs.) in Computer Applications.	CIS 120
<b>Science</b>	<b>Sciences</b>
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) of science, either physical or life science; one course must have a laboratory component.	Any college level Astronomy, Biology, Botany, Chemistry, Geology, Microbiology, Physics, Physical Science, or Zoology
<b>History</b>	<b>History</b>
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) of history.	Any College level History
<b>Humanities</b>	<b>Humanities</b>
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) with one course in the comparative study of the arts and the other selected from approved humanities courses.	Architecture 104, 105; Art 103, 114, 130; Fine Arts 103,104,105,107,108,110; Humanities 201, 202; Music 121; Philosophy; Theatre 134
<b>Literature</b>	<b>Literature</b>
One course (3 sem. hrs.) in literature.	Any college level Literature; Humanities 205, 207
<b>Social Science</b>	<b>Social Science</b>
Two courses (6 sem. hrs.) in social science with courses selected from two different disciplines.	Any college level Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology, or Social Science 101,102
<b>General Education Electives</b>	<b>General Education Electives</b>
One course (3 sem. hrs.) selected from science, history, humanities, literature, mathematics, social science.	May be completed by taking additional courses from the above beyond the required number of semester hours.
<b>Senior Seminar</b>	
One course (3 sem. hrs.) in ethics, to be taken at Columbia as a capstone general education experience.	
<b>Total 16 courses</b> (48 sem. hrs.)
