### Television

The Television Department offers a major in Television with concentrations in Writing and Producing, Production/Directing, Effects/Post-Production, and Interactive Television. In addition, an interdisciplinary major in Broadcast Journalism is offered in cooperation with Columbia College Chicago's Journalism Department.
