Transfer Credit From IAR

Successful completion of the Institute of Audio Research program (900 contact hours) will allow students to transfer up to 20 semester credit hours to Columbia College Chicago.

The Transfer Process

Transfer students must pass Columbia's Basic Audio Systems final exam with a C or better grade to meet the prerequisites for advanced study in Columbia's Audio Art & Acoustics Major and to have the 20 IAR transfer credits applied to the major, as determined by the department.

Transfer students who do not pass this exam must enroll their first semester at Columbia in 43-2110 Basic Audio Systems and will have fewer credits applied toward the major, as determined by the Audio Arts and Acoustics Department. Credits not applied toward the major will transfer to Columbia as college wide electives.
