### **Arts, Entertainment and Media Management**

### **Transfer Admission Guidelines**

AEMM courses are divided into Core, Level Two, and Concentration courses in Fashion/Retail Management. At least half of the Level Two courses should be taken at Columbia College Chicago. Concentration courses in Fashion/Retail Management should be selected with an AEMM Faculty Advisor from Columbia College Chicago. See the AEMM departmental [web site](#) for Concentration Courses.
