The Radio Department offers a major in Radio with concentrations in Talent/Production or Business. An Interdisciplinary major in Broadcast Journalism-Radio is also offered.

**Transfer Admission Guidelines**

Radio courses are divided into Core and Concentration courses. Concentration courses should be selected with a Radio Faculty Advisor from Columbia College. See the Radio Departmental brochure for course titles. **Transfer students must submit either a five minutes scoped audition tape from a one hour show or a production tape with five samples of work.**
