WHAT COLUMBIA IS DOING

- Adhering to the most current guidance from government and health agencies, and consulting with experts from Rush and the University of Chicago.
- Daily cleaning of common areas and frequently touched surfaces. Cleaning supplies are available, and employees are encouraged to clean and disinfect workspaces throughout the workday.
- Making cleaning supplies available, and encouraging employees to clean and disinfect workspaces throughout the workday as needed.
- Providing hand sanitizer throughout campus at all buildings.
- Reducing capacity and limiting seating in classrooms, meeting rooms and other communal areas.
- Requiring all employees and visitors entering campus buildings to self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms and possible exposure.
- Mandating COVID-19 vaccination for students and strongly recommending vaccination for employees.
- Mandating frequent COVID-19 testing for community members who are not vaccinated.
- Offering COVID-19 testing and vaccination on campus.
- Regularly providing updates and educating the campus community regarding health and safety practices and policies.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

- Stay home if you are sick.
- Wash your hands frequently or use hand sanitizer.
- Cover your nose and mouth when sneezing or coughing.
- Replace handshakes with head nods and waves.
- Wear a face covering and maintain recommended social distancing practices, and test regularly if you are not vaccinated.
- Stay informed and updated on the latest guidance provided by government and health agencies, and by the College.
- Be kind. Understand that this is a stressful time for everyone.
