The **Acting and Contemporary Performance Making MA** helps you take your craft to the next level by staging productions and sharpening your business and research skills. You'll develop a thesis project and graduate with business skills and networking experience that will expand your career options.

To earn a **Master of Arts in Acting and Contemporary Performance Making at Columbia**, you **must complete 30 credit hours**. The below chart reflects the typical costs of a full-time student in this program:

- The estimated **direct expenses** include tuition and fees for the program based on 2023-24 tuition rates. Tuition rates are subject to annual increases. You will be billed by Columbia for direct expenses after you register for each semester of the program.
- The estimated **indirect expenses** reflect the average cost of attending college full-time in Chicago and include estimates for books and supplies, room and board, and transportation. You will not be billed by Columbia for indirect expenses and your actual expenses may vary.

We recommend that you submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (studentaid.gov) with the Columbia school code of 001665 for the academic year that you plan to begin your graduate program.
